Licensed Independent Social Workers (LISW)

Our Behavioral Health providers are licensed with the State of Ohio Counselor, Social Worker, Marriage and Family Therapist Board. They provide Diagnostic Assessments, Treatment Planning, and Talk Therapy.

The Diagnostic Assessment is an information gathering tool to help your Behavioral Health provider learn more about your situation and to determine the best course of treatment to meet

Talk Therapy helps clients identify main life stressors, develop effective coping strategies for dealing with stress and adopt healthy living

We work with children, age 6 and up, and adults. Examples of issues we address are: Depression, Anxiety, PTSD, ADHD, Relational Issues, Bipolar Disorder, Anger Issues, Stress Management, Grief Issues, Chronic/Terminal

Illness, and other diagnoses.

Our LISWs are unable to prescribe any medications for your mental health needs. However, the LISW may help determine if you would benefit from medication. If it is determined you can be safely and appropriately treated by primary care providers, you will be referred to a medical provider at TSFHS or to a family doctor of your choice.
